INSTRUCTIONS

This form is to be filled out and filed as OIL ADKUS-REMAVE with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, indicating both the unit from which oil or gas is produced and the unit to which it is to be moved. Each transporter authorized to transport oil or gas must have an After and Certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission. One copy must be forwarded to the transporter; one copy returned to the District Office; and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate must be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the transportation unit. In the case of a temporary change in the transporter involved, the maximum allowable production for one production period. The operator shall file with the District Office a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office of the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter. Such letter and transporter shall also be furnished such temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate shall be executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall be used to permit for pipeline connection and authorization to transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- a. The certificate ownership change.
- b. The transporter is changed or
- c. The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the time this report is filed, explain fully under the heading "REMARKS".

In all cases where this form is filed to cover a change in operating ownership, the transporter, or unit designated to move oil or gas, show under "REMARKS" the name of the new operator and the transporter previously authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate form is to be filed for each in the unit designated by the Oil Conservation Commission.
