In accordance with Order R-520 the undersigned hereby requests a non-standard gas unit consisting of 160 acres in Lea County, New Mexico as follows:

1. The complete legal description of acreage included in unit is: E/2 SE/4 NW SE/4 and SE/4 NE/4 of Section 32, T. 18S, R. 87E, Lea County, New Mexico, containing 160 acres.
2. Schermernhorn Oil Corporation, Linam "A" #1 completed gas well is located 1,980' from East and South lines of Section 32.
3. Plat is attached showing acreage to be included in the unit, the well location and all offset lease ownership.
4. It is the intention of the operator to produce the gas well from the Queen formation as a non-standard gas unit comprising 160 acres in the Eumont gas pool.

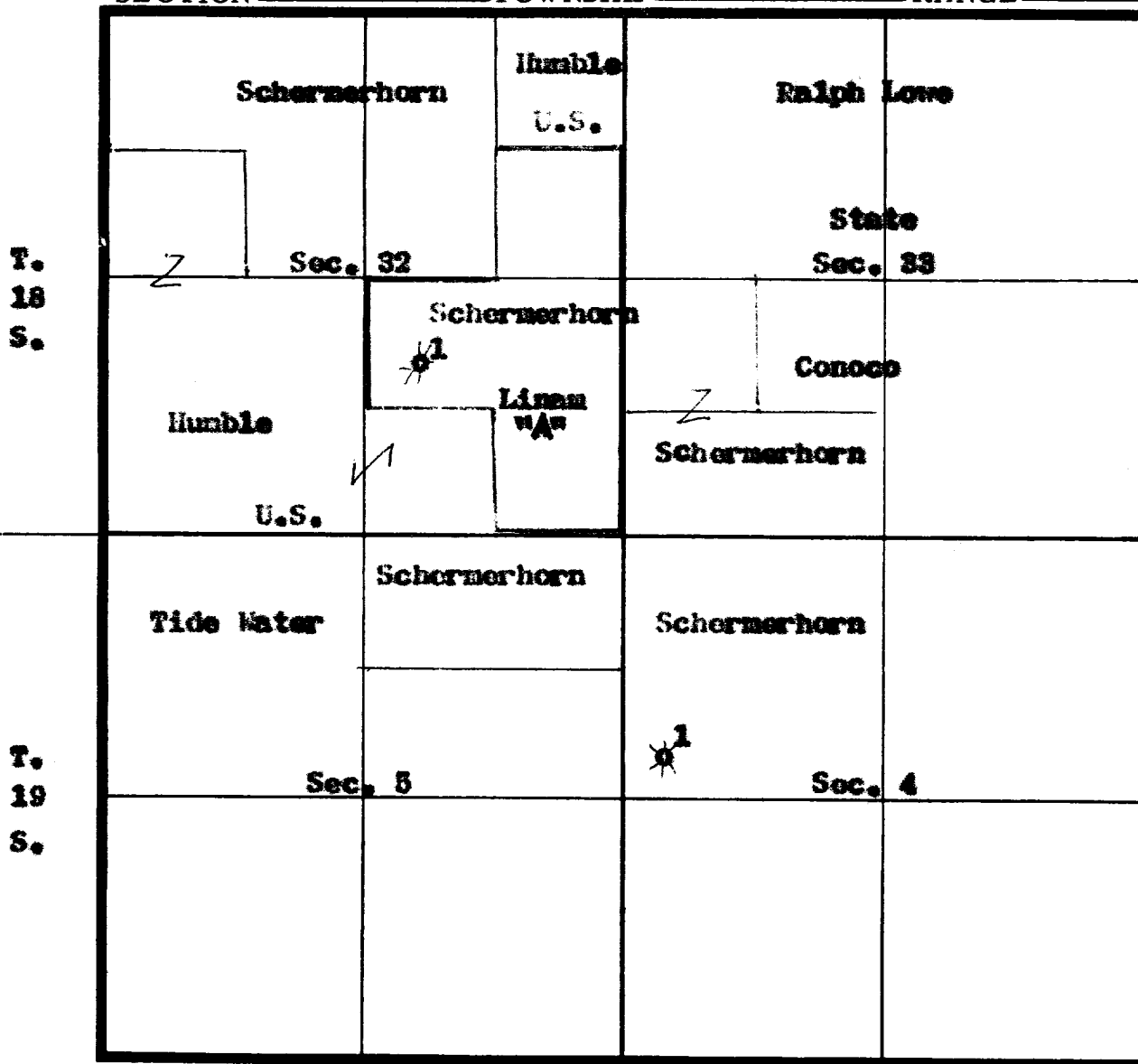
