Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-520 for the formation of a 120-acre non-standard gas production unit consisting of Units I, J, and K of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 37 East, for its State C-33 No. 3 well located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5(b) in all respects as follows:

1. Said proposed non-standard gas production unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
2. Said proposed non-standard gas production unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed non-standard gas production unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5(b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 3 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.
