#### DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

This well was drilled to a depth of 4272 in ebruary, 1931, and no work has been done on it since. Drilling was discontinued when they struck sulphur water, and the records show it was plugged back to 4188. The 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  inch casing was cemented at 3878. Well now showing seepage of both gas and oil. We propose to rig up, clean out and ~~recondition~~ well.
