Dear Dr. Wells:

This is in reply to your letter of September 15th, regarding the bond of the National Securities Oil Company.

You are advised that the Linam Well No. 1, in Sec. 33, T. 18 S., R. 37 E., is now being plugged. As a matter of interest, when the plugging operators were trying to pull the 8" casing the well started to flow a little oil. Mr. Staley visited the well and asked that a test be made to determine the amount of oil. The well was bailed down and it was found that this was most likely a little show that had been cased off and was of no commercial value, so the plugging was resumed.

As soon as the final report is in, I shall advise you.
