### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

- (1). Drilled cement from 5-inch liner to 4245 feet.
- (2). Reperforated 5-inch liner from 4201' to 4209'.
- (3). Added new perforations with 500 gallons acid.
- (4). Placed back on production by snubbing and flowing.
- (5). On last test flowed 112 barrels oil and 20 barrels water (15%) through 28/64-inch choke in 24 hours. Gas volume too small to measure. Production increased 110 barrels oil per day.
