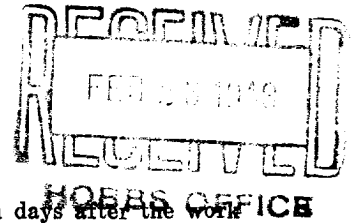

- (1) Acidized formation through liner perforations 4186 to 4196 feet with 3000 gallons 15% acid in 115 minutes. Swabbed 63 barrels oil and 51 barrels acid water in 28 hours. Well failed to flow.
- (2) Acidized formation through liner perforations 4186 to 4196 feet with 5000 gallons 15% acid in 40 minutes. Well swabbed and flowed 208 barrels fluid in 22 hours.
