NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in **State**
Well No. **1** in **SW/4** of Sec. **17**, T. **18**, R. **38**,
N. M. P. M., **Hobbs** Oil Field **Lee** County,
on **February 8,** 19 **33** **12-1/2 - 80** lb. casing was **4444** cemented in **Red bed**
formation at a depth of **214** feet on **February 8,** 19 **33**
178 sacks of **El Toro** cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Haliburton Oil Well Cementing Company, plug used with pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of **222 214** feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
