NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Boon Hardin  
Well No. 3 in NW 4 of SW 4 of Sec. 18, T. 18, R. 39,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,  
on Feb. 27th 1933 9 5/8" 36# lb. casing was cemented in Anhydrite  
formation at a depth of 2803' feet on Feb. 24, 1933 19  
300 Lone Star  
150 Incor sacks of cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Malliburton

600# pressure will be placed on well for 30 min. before & after drilling plug

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
