Dear Sir:

I am enclosing a list showing the state requirements in regard to reports on drilling wells. Trusting this will help you to keep up with what we want. I am send these out with all "Approved" Notice of Intention to Drill New Wells.

I think I told you that I would like to be there when you make any of the following tests: water shut-off on surface; test on 9-5/8" and 7" pipe. I will appreciate it if you will call me for them.

Dr. Wells will get a bulletin out soon covering the new regulations that were discussed at the meeting on January 31st. For your information I will outline the requirements. As follows:

Surface pipe: Bail dry and wait 2 hrs.
9-5/8": Same as above or 600# pressure test for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug.
7": Same as surface or 1200# pressure test for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug.

I am hoping these requirements will meet with the approval of all of the operators, I personally think they are quite an improvement.
