A C-102 was submitted April 1, 1952 requesting approval to P & A Hardin Well No. 4 and approval was obtained. However, this work was not completed.

It is proposed to shut this well in until it is determined that recompletion as a gas well is neither feasible nor economical. The oil line and tubing have been reclaimed and the casing gate closed. This well was included in the casing test program conducted recently on this lease and no leaks were present. It is believed that this procedure is amply justified both from an economic and a conservation standpoint.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Total depth of Hardin No. 4 is 4204' with the 7" oil string cemented at 3945'. The open hole will be filled with cement and the 7" casing filled with mud-laden fluid to the point where the 7" casing is cut off. A cement plug will be set at this point and another cement plug in the bottom of the 9" casing which is set at 2770'. The 9" casing will be filled with mud-laden fluid to the point where it is cut off where another cement plug will be set and then fill the hole with mud loaded fluid to the bottom of the 12 1/2" casing which is set at 230'. A cement plug will be set in the bottom and top of the 12 1/2" casing with a 4" pipe marker set in the top plug. This well is being abandoned due to mechanical difficulties. An application to drill well No. 5 as a replacement for well No. 4 on this unit is being filed.
