Pursuant to verbal agreements regarding the operation of this well the following actions will be continued for the life of the well - Documented weekly lease operator inspections of the production (5 1/2") casing for no flow or pressure.

Please accept the three attached charts from pressure tests ran 04/21/95. A packer was set at 0777 feet from surface. Also an unrecorded pressure test was done on the section of casing from 0777 to 4007. This test held 500 psig for 30 minutes.

Evelyn,

Pursuant to our telephone conversation and my subsequent meeting with Jerry on the subject well, we have now completed our casing repairs as requested by your office.

Following the cement squeeze and drill out, the well was tested to 330 PSI and charted. We are sending you the original test charts for your records. Chart number one shows the pressure bleeding from 330 PSI to 230 PSI in 67 minutes. It then held the 230 PSI for 29 minutes. Chart number two shows the pressure bleeding from 230 to 225 PSI in 96 minutes.

Jerry reviewed the tests with me and agreed that the well is repaired properly. We will continue to monitor this well for any future problems. Should you have any additional questions, please call.
