DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After setting Packer at 4100' all fluid was shut off, treated well with 250-gallons of delayed acid, after standing for a few hours was swabbed out recovering the 168-bbls of oil used in treating the well. After standing for 16-hours well was opened up and it flowed on its own power 29.04-bbls of pipe line oil with an estimated 100,000 cu ft gas. Plan on treating again to-morrow.
