DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

This well will be killed by pumping oil into the tubing. It is then proposed to repair the producing White Line Section by placing approximately 1000 gallons of Commercial Hydrochloric Acid Solution in the bottom of the hole. The well will then be shut in for about 72 hours before it is placed back on production.

The present potential of this well is 3144 barrels of oil and a Gas-Oil Ration of 3180 cu. ft. gas per barrel of oil. Was 1730 cu. ft. gas per barrel of oil before setting a packer.

It is recommended that this well be treated with acid to correct the high gas-oil ratio.
