DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated this well with 1000 gallons acid pumped into pay formation from 4207' to 4238' with 700# pressure. Chased acid with 65 bbls oil and then shut well in. Left well shut in for 48 hours and then commenced producing normally thru 28/64" choke for ten days, as required by the Proration Office, and then tested well for new potential. Received new potential of 10,300 barrels per day and, effective March 16th, 1934, daily allowance was increased to 215 barrels.
