NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in H. D. McKinley
Well No. 1 in SW cor. of Sec. 20, T. 18, R. 33,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on October 7, 1932 7" - 24" lb. casing was which cemented in line
formation at a depth of 4040 feet on October 7, 1932
200 sacks sacks of Bl Togo Portland cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Process under pressure with pump and plug.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of _____ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
