NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in H. D. McKinley
Well No. 1 in SW cor. of Sec. 20, T. 18 S, R. 38 E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Box County,
on September 10, 19 32. 12-1/2-50# lb. casing was cemented in Red Bed
formation at a depth of 213 feet on September 10, 19 32
200 sacks of El Toro Portland cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Halliburton Oil Well Cementin Process under pressure with pumps and plug.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 213 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
