NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

on April 9 19 33 7", 24 lb. casing was ~~placed~~ cemented in sandy lime
formation at a depth of 4056 feet on April 4, 19 33
275 sacks of El Toro Special ON cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Process

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of see below feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Additional information: Casing will be tested with 1200 pressure. After drilling out cement, a Halliburton Tester run on dry 3" drill pipe, and set at 4020' will be opened and allowed to stand for 1 hour to test water shut off. State Oil & Gas Inspector J. B. Hunter was advised verbally of our intention to make this test.
