### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On pulling tubing to put well on pump we found that the 7" oil string had parted at 318'.

We ran 5 1/2" N80 17# Xline liner with Brown packer type liner hanger on bottom inside of 7" set liner at 592 packing off break at a point 271' below where casing is parted.

After this work was done we found that the well has a shutoff above the packer on outside of liner. The well now flows and produces no water. On production test well will flow at rate of 70 BOD with 800# casing pressure. At its daily rate of 40BOD casing pressure is lower. Prior to setting liner the well had started to produce in excess of 100 BOD of water and would not produce its allowable.
