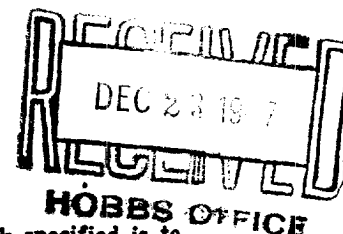

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Hole was drilled to depth of 4070' and 5½" fourteen pound casing was cemented with 350 sacks one foot off bottom. Plug was pumped down at Noon on December 20, 1947.

Pressure was released after 20 hours and a temperature survey run to determine top of cement. Same was found at 2790', or 20 feet above the base of salt.

Cement will be allowed 48 hours set time before plug is drilled and casing pressure tested.
