DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pressure tested 5 1/2-inch casing (bottom 4225) with 1000 pounds for 30 minutes. Held O.K. Drilled out cement to 4192 and perforated casing from 4160 to 4180 and from 4110 to 4130. Acidized through both perforations with 150 gallons acid. On official gas oil ratio test flowed 216 barrels oil out 5/10% B.S. in 24 hours through 15/64-inch choke with tubing pressure of 400 pounds and gas oil ratio of 461. Packer set in casing at 3875.
