NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL RE: THE PROSECUTION OF THE CASE OF JAMES EARL RAY

The following information was received from the Memphis office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation on May 1, 1968:

On May 1, 1968, James Earl Ray, a white male, was arrested in London, England, on charges of being the assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Ray was arrested by British police officers who were acting on information received from a confidential source of the Memphis office. Ray was taken to the London Police Station and held in custody.

On May 2, 1968, Ray was flown to Memphis, Tennessee, where he was held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 3, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of first degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 4, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of second degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 5, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of third degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 6, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of fourth degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 7, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of fifth degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 8, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of sixth degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 9, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of seventh degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 10, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of eighth degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 11, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of ninth degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.

On May 12, 1968, Ray was arraigned in the Memphis Federal Court on charges of tenth degree murder. He is currently being held in the Memphis Federal Detention Center.
