Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

Pumped in additional 52bbbls/oil. Casing pressure dropped to 475 - Pumped acid down tbg. under vacuum. Loaded acid w/45bbbls. oil. Tbg. pressure vacuum. csg. press. rose from 475# to 550#. Well stood shut in 72hrs. Official Proration Test was made on 10/26/34. Flowed @ 7216bbbls/oil/day, plus 5.55% B.S.& drlg. water and 8mil. cu. ft.
