DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

This well has been acidized w/2000 gallons acid. However, the increase obtained is insufficient to protect the lease from unequitable drainage. Therefore, to protect the lease from drainage it is desired to re-treat w/6000 gallons acid. The well will be filled w/dead oil. The tubing will then be filled w/acid while oil is being drawn from the csg. When the tbg is filled w/acid the casing will be closed and the remaining acid will be forced down the tbg and into the productive horizon. The acid will be followed w/sufficient oil to void tbg and csg of acid, and force the acid out beyond the sphere of activity of the first treatment.
