## NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in

Well No. 2 in SE 1/4 of Sec. 28, T. 18S, R. 38E,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,  
on 12-4-34 19 10-3/4" 40# lb. casing was { lined } in Red Beds  
formation at a depth of 243 feet on 12-1-34 19  
150 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

**Pumped down with Halliburton method.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 243' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Shell Petroleum Corpn.

**Plug will be drilled & 2' of hole made below cement, Casing will be bailed dry & test made for water shut off, Test Will be made about 1201 AM Dec 4th, 1934.**
