NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in W.D. Grimes
Well No. 2 in SE 1/4 of Sec. 28, T. 18S, R. 30E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on 12-11-34 19 7-5/8" 26# lb. casing was { ~~boxed~~ cemented } in Anhydrite
formation at a depth of 1634' feet on 12-6-34 19
300 sacks of Eltore cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Pumped in by Halliburton method.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 1634 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Additional information:

Pipe will be tested with 600# Pressure before drilling plug and
with 600# pressure after drilling plug. Test for 30 Minutes on each test.
