NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to send. Submit this notice in triplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut off of water in W. D. Grimes Well No. 3 in NW 1/4 of Sec. 28, T. 18S, R. 38 E., N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field, Lea County, on June 22, 1934. 10" in. 45 lb. casing was cemented in formation at a depth of 2703'-10" on June 22, 1934. 150 sacks of 51 Torc cement was used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 2690' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
