NW/4 of Sec. 28, T. 18-S, R. 36-E, N. M. P. M.,
Hebbs Oil Field, Lea County.

The dates of this work were as follows: From April 24th to May 22, 1935.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Started to pull tubing on April 27th; Tubing parted near bottom; left approx. 59' of tubing in hole; set Whip stock with 34 sacks cement. Bottom of whipstock set at 4132'; Top of whipstock set at 4114. Drilled from 4223 to 4268' in line. Swabbed well into sulphur water; plugged back from 4268' to 4265' with 10 sacks cement.

Well produced 50 bbls. pipe line oil first hr. after swabbing in. Production dropped to 20 bbls. per hr. flowing wide open through 3" tubing.
