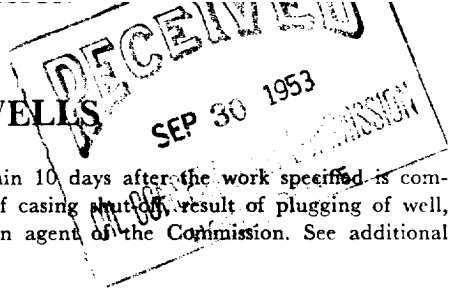


MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS ON WELLS
