DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 4214' - Drilled well to Total Depth 4253'. Set 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " liner at 4228' with 50 sacks Starco Cement, liner setting 50' up in 7" casing. Failed to cement off bottom hole water, ran 3" EUE tubing and cemented with 80 sacks of Starco cement. Well drilled to 4253' TD. Set 4-1/4" Exner-Dodge Formation Packer at 4230'. Treated with 500 gallons of Dowell X Acid. Well flowed 166 barrels of pipe line oil in 17 hours on 16/64" choke.
