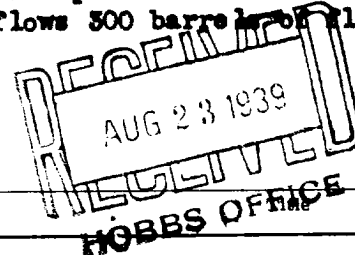

**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Pulled tubing and rerun same to TD 4000' with 6 Williamson flow valves @ 1000'; 1375'; 1750'; 2125'; 2500'; and 2875'. Kicked with input gas. Well started flowing. Input gas is being obtained from high pressure separator at our State A Lease, well # 2, located in Section 32-18s-38e, in line with your authorization of August 9th., 1939. Before the installation of valves, this well had declined to a point where it would not flow. With the present use of intermittent input gas, well flows 300 barrels of fluid daily, 75% water, with a gas/oil ratio of 1000.
