Ran 102 Joints of 2" EUE 4.7# 8 RT, R-2, J-55 SS Tubing and set at 3210' with
1-3' Perforated Nipple on bottom Bull Plug ed and 2-6' Subs on Top and pumped
25 barrel of water into casing and well started flowing. Clean up into pits
and turned into tanks at 1:30PM December 23, 1946 and in 17 1/2 hours on 1/2" Choke
made 201.29 Barrels of Oil Casing Pressure 300# Tubing Pressure 25#, Gas Volume
114M and Gas-Oil-Ratio of 434. Well Completed.
