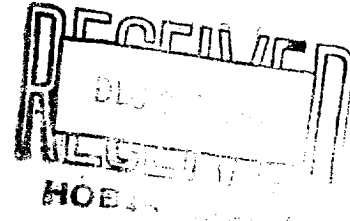

3142' Total Depth, Nippled up and went in hole with Tubing and found top of cement at 3068', tested with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK, drilled out cement and tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK, Mixed 290 Sacks Baroid, 50 Sacks Aquagel, 50# Caustic Soda, 250# Quebracho and started making 4 3/4" hole at 3:38AM December 22, 1946
