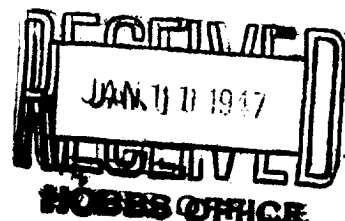

3137' Total Depth, Ran 98 Joints of 5 1/2" OD 15.5#, J-55, K-2, 2 RT Spang Seamless Casing and set at 3137' and cemented with 344 Sacks Common Atlas Cement and 50 Sacks Interior Cement, and pumped plug to 3075' at 6PM January 9, 1947 and Final Pressure was 400#. Halliburton truck broke down and could only get 344 sacks out of truck instead of 550 Sacks.
