DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

bradenhead Check: With tubing pressure 700 psi, 7" casing pressure 1000 psi, 9 5/8" casing pressure 300 psi, and 12 3/4" casing pressure 0 psi, the 9 5/8" bradenhead was opened. The 9 5/8" casing pressure dropped to 0 psi in 15 minutes, and the 7" casing pressure remained at 1000 psi.

Temperature and Pressure Survey: On 6-16-40 due to presence of holes in the 3" tubing and not being able to pull the packer set at 4101' in the open hole, a string of 1 1/4" tubing was run with a pony packer set in the 3" tubing at 4080' and the well has produced thru the 1 1/4" tubing since that time. Due to the mechanical condition of this well and in the absence of any communication indicated on the bradenhead check, an exemption is requested on the temperature and pressure surveys.
