## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set Baker Retrievable Retainer at 3502' on 2" tbg. and cemented below with 150 sacks of cement. Top of cement 3627'.

Perforated 7" casing from 3155' to 3175' with 120 shots.

On December 6, 1946, the well flowed 193 bbls. oil in 5-1/2 hrs. from 7" casing thru 2" gate valve.

Ran 2" tubing with Baker production packer set at 3087'.
