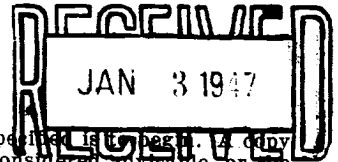

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

1. To deepen well approximately 40' to third zone in Hobbs pay.
2. Run 5-1/2" liner from total depth into 7" casing.
3. Cement liner from total depth to 7" casing.
4. Perforate liner opposite the oil zones in Hobbs pay.
5. Run 2-3/8" tubing with packer.
