FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

1. Run 5" casing to total depth and cement to surface.
2. Deepen well approximately 50' to third zone in Hobbs Pay.
3. Run Gamma Ray and Neutron Log to total depth.
4. Perforate opposite upper Hobbs Gas Zone 3964'-4020'.
5. Run 2-3/8" tubing with packer set below perforations.
6. Produce oil through tubing and gas, for gas-lift purposes, through annulus.
