DETAILS OF WORK

1. Kill well with light bentonite and containing fibrous material.
2. Pull tubing and packer.
3. Set bridge plug near bottom of 7" casing.
4. Run retrievable retriever to check 7" casing for leaks. If found to be leaking, drill well to approximately 505' sub sea, run 5 1/2" casing to total depth and perforate as determined by electric log. 5 1/2" casing to be cemented back to surface in two stages.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
