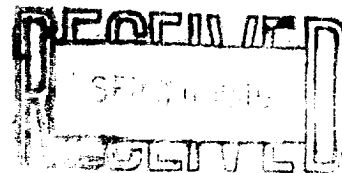

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

In preparing this well for recompletion in the bowers sand it was found that the 7"OD oil string was in bad condition, making it necessary to run a string of 5-1/2" casing on the inside. We ran 5-1/2" OD 15.5# Seamless Steel Casing and set at 3,350' ~~10,000'~~ and cemented with 100 sacks. This casing was tested with 1200# pressure and let stand for 30 minutes to check for decline, held OK.
