## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was drilled to a total depth of 2755' and abandoned in 1930, after setting string of 9-5/8" OD casing at 2755' and cementing with 600 sacks. This well is located 2310' from the North line and 330' from the East line of Section 30-18S-38E, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our intention to deepen the well to the Bowers pay zone with an expected total depth of around 3200' and after setting string of 7" OD casing at approximately 3125' and cement with 200 sacks. Contractor who is to deepen this well will be the Cactus Drilling Company of San Angelo, Texas. First pay is expected at around 3185'. We propose to deepen the well with rotary tools.
