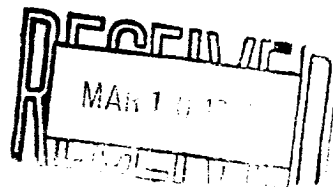

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3230' Total Depth, Shot with 10 Quarts Nitroglycerin from 3196' to 3205', 2 1/2" x 10' Shell, with 24' of Anchor, R. A. Time Bomb and Bolshevik Cave Catcher, Shot went off at 6AM March 3, 1947, went in hole with bit and found bridge at 3040' and cleaned out to bottom, finished at 8PM March 3, 1947, ran 2" EOL tubing 104 joints to 3205' with 3' perforated nipple on bottom bull plugged and 1-4', 2-6' and 1-8' sub on top, Swabbed 3 hours into pits estimated of 60 barrels and into tanks 6 hours 22.01 barrels oil 4/100 BS, Made trip with tubing and put on 12' Anchor bull plugged, 3' perforated Nipple, seating nipple, 104 jts 2" EOL tubing with 1-4', 2-6' and 1-8' sub on top, tubing set at 3218', Seating nipple at 3205'
