3230' Total Anhydrite, Finished 4 3/4" hole at 4:15 PM March 1, 1947 and acidized well with 500 Gallons of Dowell XF-18 acid with Maximum Casing Pressure of 2000# and Tubing Pressure of 1700# after 12 barrels oil flush, rigged up and swabbed into pits 3 1/2 hours estimate of 75 barrels of fluid and into tanks for 4 hours and made 12.63 barrels fluid 4 1/2 US & 6 1/2 Water. We intend to shoot with 10 quarts Nitroglycerine from 3196 to 3204'.
