DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Nov. 25, 1935, 1,000 gallons of acid was pumped down the tubing as slowly as possible in order to place acid in bottom of hole. The stimulation took the acid under vacuum. 142 barrels of oil was pumped down the tubing to force the acid out of the tubing. On Nov. 25th, the well made 142 barrels of oil in 24 hours with a ratio of 5100 and a tubing pressure of 1200/ against a 7/8" choke.
