A permit for a temporary transportation of the oil or gas produced in the oil or gas lease to the Commission, by the owner of the lease, or by the temporary transporter, is required for the transportation of such oil or gas. Such permit shall be issued by the Commission, upon application therefor, if the applicant is a qualified person, and if the oil or gas is to be transported for a period of not more than 90 days, and if the oil or gas is to be transported for a distance of not more than 10 miles from the wellhead. The permit shall be issued for a period of not more than 90 days, and shall be subject to the following conditions:

This permit shall be issued and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission and shall be subject to the following conditions and authorization to the permittee to transport oil and gas to the specified place and shall remain in full force and effect.
