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ARTICLE 10

Oil or gas shall not be transported from a well or mine to a point of sale or delivery, or from a point of sale or delivery to a point of sale or delivery, unless the transporter has obtained a certificate of authority from the Oil Conservation Commission.

The certificate of authority shall be issued by the Oil Conservation Commission, upon application by the transporter, and shall be valid for a period of one year. The certificate shall specify the amount of oil or gas to be transported, the route of transport, and the name of the transporter.

The transporter shall file a copy of the certificate of authority with the Oil Conservation Commission, and shall retain a copy of the certificate for the period of one year.

The transporter shall also file a copy of the certificate of authority with the local oil and gas commission, and shall retain a copy of the certificate for the period of one year.

If any of the provisions of this article are violated, the transporter shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100, and to imprisonment for not more than 30 days.

In addition to the fine and imprisonment, the transporter shall be liable to a civil penalty of not more than \$100, and to a suspension of the certificate of authority for a period of not more than 30 days.

A court of competent jurisdiction may, in its discretion, suspend the certificate of authority for a period of not more than 30 days, if the transporter fails to comply with the provisions of this article.

The transporter shall also file a copy of the certificate of authority with the District Attorney, and shall retain a copy of the certificate for the period of one year. The transporter shall also file a copy of the certificate of authority with the local oil and gas commission, and shall retain a copy of the certificate for the period of one year.

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In addition to the fine and imprisonment, the transporter shall be liable to a civil penalty of not more than \$100, and to a suspension of the certificate of authority for a period of not more than 30 days.
