Total Depth 4215' Lime. F. B. 4086'. Set 7" Model 3 B Baker cast iron bridge plug at 3940'. Dumped cement on top of bridge plug with dump bailer. Top of cement at 3914'. Perforated 7" casing at following intervals W/4 jet shots per foot: 3758' to 3770', 3785' to 3797', 3810' to 3825', 3840' to 3850'. The Byers formation was not capable of producing gas in commercial quantities. Completed final report.
