Total Depth 4215' - P.B. 4086'. An attempt was made to get this well back on production in November 1950. As it has not produced since May 1950 the attempt failed. We have been swabbing and testing for some 2 months and the well is making 98% water. It is the intention of The Ohio Oil Company to set a 7" Baker retainer at 3940', plug back to 3870' with cement. Then perforate 7" casing from 3750' to 3850' and make Byers gas well.
