DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Fowler No. 7 was cleaned out to total depth of 3052', hot oiled and sand fractured with 20,000 gallons of lease oil and 30,000# of sand, rate 34.2 barrel per minute at 2550 pounds maximum. Total load and treatment 1055 barrel. Cleaned out 8' of cavings with sand pump after releasing pressure. The well was swabbed and entire load was recovered. The well was produced to clean-up and on a controlled test, it flowed 61 barrel of clean oil in 24 hours, choke 12/64", FTP 250#, FCP 450#, gravity 41 deg at 60, GOR 400. Prior to clean-out and fracing, the well produced 3 barrel of oil per day on artificial lift.
