## NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Clara Fowler  
Well No. 1 in NW/4 of Sec. 31, T. 18, R. 38,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,  
on Sept. 4th 19 30 7"-24 lb. casing was { landed } in Anhydrite  
formation at a depth of 3973 feet on August 28th 19 30  
450 sacks of El Tero cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Cemented through 7" casing with cement plug.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 3973 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
